September 26, 2017: Drafts of Slide Decks

MTI usually asks for a draft of a proposal or request to provide applicants with feedback on what will be submitted, do I need to submit a draft of my slide deck and are you reviewing drafts of decks before we submit?

With MTI's other programs, a written application providing a high level of detail is required for first review. To ensure that potential applicants put their best foot forward and spend time refining time-intensive applications, we suggest providing a draft of the proposal for staff feedback.

In the case of MTAF2.0, the submission of the slide deck itself is the mechanism for feedback. It is not necessary to provide a draft of your deck prior to submission. Because no final funding decisions will be made based on the only the decks, we anticipate that the more intensive MTI staff time will be spent after the decks are submitted.
