The federal SBIR/STTR program offers innovative small business and entrepreneurs the opportunity to access over \$3.7 billion in equity-free funding. This program is highly competitive — only about 10–15% of Phase I applications are approved. Plus, navigating a federal grant process can be daunting, especially for a small business with limited resources.

- Expanded follow-on assistance and support for the Phase II proposal.

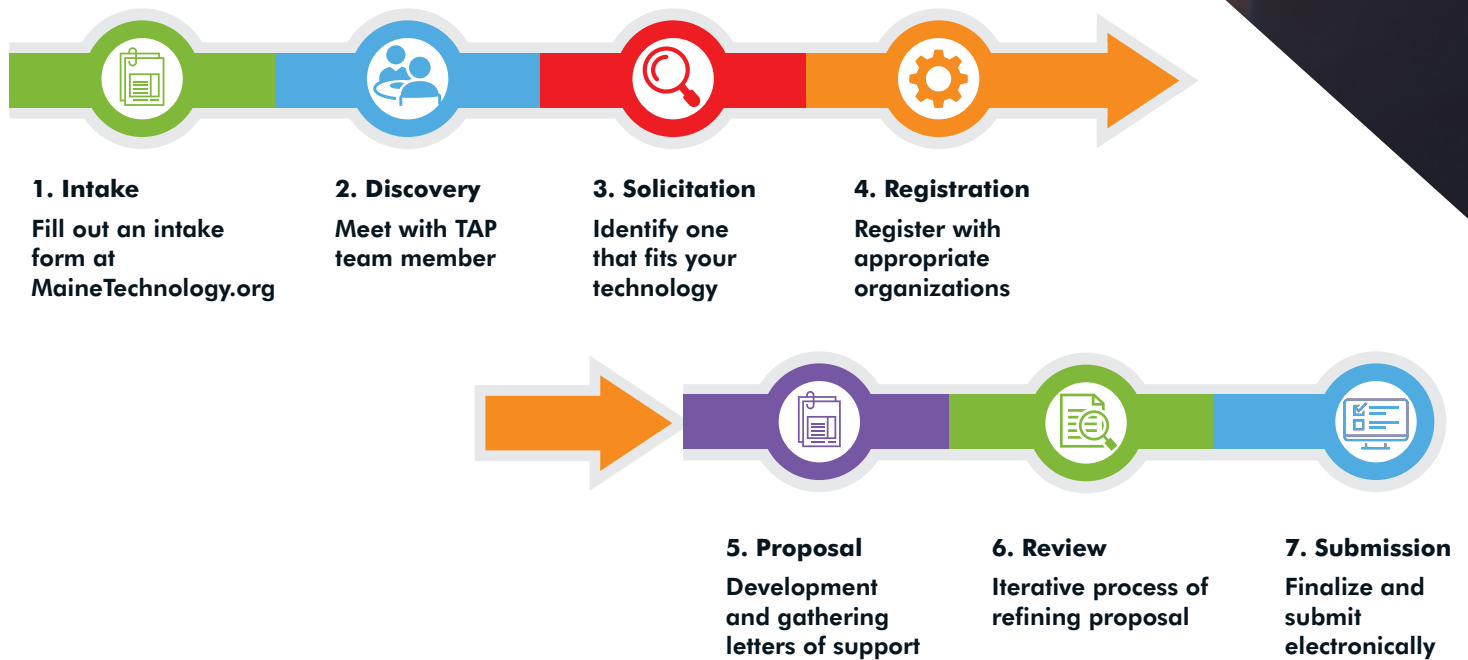
